^e ADB placed its regular assistance to Afghanistan on hold effective 15 August 2021, but since 2022 has supported the economic and social development of the Afghan people through a special arrangement with the United Nations to address basic human needs, including critical food support, and health and education services.

^f Effective 1 February 2021, ADB placed a temporary hold on sovereign project disbursements and new contracts in Myanmar. In 2023, ADB committed a special financing arrangement of \$26 million to provide humanitarian support to the people of Myanmar.
